NEXT STEPS:

1. Produce statement of intent (LN)
2. Electronic copy of map of Parish to be sent to Helen Chadwick (Clerk TPC). (HHR)
3. Once agreed Parish Council to send Statement of intent and map to HRH. Statement to be signed by Tom Prior and Helen Chadwick.
4. Once received there is a six week consultation period. The map and statement shall be advertised by:
 - a. Charnwood BC (possibly) in the Melton Echo and borough council website. (HHR)
 - b. TPC in Thrussington Life. (TPC).
 - c. Chief executive to sign the plan for adoption (if no objections).

OTHER NOTES:

1. Statement of intent should be forwarded by the PC and include the boundaries of the plan, why TPC are pursuing a NP (for example – “To preserve the identity and character of the village”).
2. During this period pursue funding. Try “Locality” who have experience. It is thought that grants of £7K are available for use on consultants, surveys etc.
3. Search for suitable consultants.
4. Discuss with other parish councils. Find out who they have used for consultants. Details of contacts will be on their websites.
Thurcaston and Cropston plan is on line. A link to be sent (HHR).
Burton on the Wolds to be asked for information on their plan. NS
5. Meet with Rural Community council organisation for advice, support, ideas about publicity.(PR)
6. Talk to LRALC (MT)
7. Go to networking meetings run by Leicestershire CC. HHR to send link. HHR

8. Think about open village meeting, questionnaire.
9. Produce rough project plan (MT) – to be forwarded to HHR when agreed.
10. Plan with “transparent” borders to be produced (NS/PG) to allow clarification of borders along the Wreake and A46 (for example).
11. Charnwood will pay for referendum and examiner.
12. Ratcliffe. Look at possibility of discussing with Ratcliffe Parish, if they want to do a NP they would need a neighbourhood forum which has some profound implications. HHR to look at the implications for our discussions. HHR
