

Footpath 7: Main St Ragdale – Ragdale Hall – Ragdale Woods – Six Hills – Ragdale Woods – Ragdale Hall – (Parish boundary towards Hoby and Thrussington) – Ragdale

Date: 10th November, 2016

Duration: 105min Walked by: M Thistlethwaite

Comments:

1. Footpaths clearly marked throughout (mostly). Footpath back to Ragdale was not easy to see -(as described below).
2. Started Main Street Ragdale but could have started in Hoby or Thrussington.



3. At end of Main Street walk across fields towards Ragdale Hall and straight across drive aiming towards the mid point of Ragdale Woods, now in Thrussington Parish.



4. Turn right and follow to end, cross the slip road from B676 to A46, across wooded area. Now at Six Hills roundabout. Footpaths continue into other Parishes here. Wooded area is somewhat overgrown.



5. Retrace path, where you previously turned towards Ragdale Hall across the field instead continue along side of woods, across field and through small wooded area with pond, across next field and around the rear of Ragdale Hall.



6. Continue through and past a farm unit. In the following field follow footpath across. In the middle of this field you would normally turn left towards a footpath back to Ragdale. You cannot easily see this from the path. I continued following the path until I intersected the paths previously walked towards Hoby / Thrussington (walk 5 and 6) to follow the Parish boundary and then retraced my steps to the field and took the Ragdale footpath which can just be seen at the bottom of this field.



7. Followed footpath towards Ragdale and thus going back into Hoby/Rotherby Parish and coming to a jetty back to Main Street (can turn right here and follow yet another footpath to Hoby).
