Comments:

1. Footpaths clearly marked throughout. The photographs showing the first part of this route are on earlier reports.

2. Footpath through fields clear and easy to follow. Last field before bridge is grazing land, there is a warning. Cattle often there.





3. Footpath to Hoby (beyond Parish Boundary) was clear – not walked.



4. Footpath to Brooksby at bridge over Wreake was clear (not walked)



5. Followed permitted path – this field often has cattle. Well marked.



6. Entrance from field path to track to railway was particularly overgrown.





This track continued to be overgrown for several hundred metres.

7. Path clear along the banks of the Wreake along the more well trodden footpath.



8. Village footpath, Back Lane to Church Lane – clear and well marked



9. Village footpath, Church Lane to Rearsby Road – clear and well marked.



10. Village footpath, Star to Seagrave Road – not very clear and not marked from Star end although marked on Seagrave Road.
