

Footpath 4: Regent Street –Hoby Road –Church Lane/Back Lane- Footpath through to and across path to Thrussington Mill– Continue on footpath over Parish boundary – over fields to Hoby. Returned via new footpath near Brooksby bridge to bridge over the Wreake – and return the same way as we went.

Comments:

Walked to Hoby along main footpath (without diverting to the mill and the Wreake) but returned via a new footpath from Hoby to Thrussington.

1. Footpath clearly marked throughout however need to be careful on new footpath.



2. Footpath through fields clear and easy to follow. Fields near Hoby had bulls.



3. The Bluebell pub is now a microbrewery so we stopped there for a bit.



4. We were going to walk back through Brooksby college and along the Wreake but a new footpath has been created near Brooksby bridge. This path skirts the edge of the field, don't go through the large metal gate as you get to a point where you can't continue without going under an electric fence. It joins one of the bridges over the Wreake (near the permitted path to the railway walk). Unfortunately halfway across the field was a large wet area we had to skirt.
