916/2021 - Resolution to approve year end accounts and certificate of exemption for 2020/2021

As the meeting was a zoom meeting it was agreed that the clerk would arrange for the Chair to sign the year end accounts and the certificate of exemption so that they could be forwarded to the auditor to meet the July deadline.

917/2021 - Resolution to approve the standing orders

919/2021 - To discuss the condition of the parish council noticeboard and agree actions

It was reported that the parish council noticeboard is in need of refurbishment or replacement. The clerk confirmed that a new noticeboard would cost in the region of £1,500 and that if councillors agreed to replace it it would need to be discussed as part of the 21/22 budget. Councillors agreed that there might be someone in the village who could repair the noticeboard in the interim and it was agreed that a notice would be included in Thrussington Life.
