Update on Proposed Housing Developments



It seems such a long time since we first featured an article about the Charnwood Local Plan in Thrussington Life. Indeed, the village first began its process of objecting when the Parish Council Working Group was formed in July 2021.

There have been a few twists and turns since then and much frustration. Below is a brief

summary of the situation as at our print deadline of mid-January. The village website https://thrussingtonvillage.org/ is updated whenever there is any significant news. If you have any comments or queries, please email ninetyhouses@gmail.com.

<u>Charnwood Local Plan</u> Further examination hearings start in Loughborough on February 20th prior to publication of the long-awaited inspectors' report. Working group members will be attending, largely with a watching brief, though discussion of the limited spaces available at the village primary school may be raised.

<u>Old Gate Road</u> It's possible that this planning application and the one below will not be determined until after the local plan is complete. Bellway continue to make minor changes to their plans including, most recently, a review of the numbers and types of affordable homes. Recent floods and sewage spills have prompted further objections to this application, based again on the additional strain that this proposed development would put on village infrastructure.

Hoby Road This application has also neither been granted nor refused and the developers submitted an appeal to Charnwood in October 2023, citing delays in dealing with it. Charnwood's planning team confirmed on January 12th that the appeal process is not currently under way as they are awaiting instructions to start from the planning inspectorate.

Homes and businesses were severely impacted and we saw major flooding in areas not previously affected or considered to be at high risk.

It's now imperative that we understand why January's floods were so bad, and how our communities can best be protected in the future. The review into the floods will be multi-agency, and we'll be working hard to make sure that residents voices and concerns are heard during such reviews. We are also asking that the flood risk assessments for all the large housing developments in the area, are reviewed in light of the flooding.

If your home or business was flooded, please make sure this is reported using the link, below, as it can make a difference to grant funding and future flood defence planning. www.leicestershire.gov.uk/ environment-and-planning/ flooding-and-drainage/reporta-flood.

If you can't use the link, please get in touch and we'll try to help. The government announced that Charnwood would be one of the areas to receive grant money for those who have been flooded. Information on how to access this will be on the Charnwood Borough Council website and via their email alerts. www.charnwood.gov.uk/ alerts.

If you aren't online, again, please get in touch.

Please also be aware that sadly, rogue traders can often take advantage during difficult times and people are being warned to be cautious about cold callers offering to do repair work. Residents are advised not to feel pressured to agree to work or payments on the doorstep and to do background checks before agreeing to work. If you feel intimidated or threatened, you should contact the police.

Despite such a devastating start to the new year, crisis often brings out the best in communities and that was certainly the case across this area and the wider Borough. And in the challenging times we're all facing recently, we'd like to let residents know of some great local community initiatives in the area. Syston has a Mental Health Café, where people can access support. The service is provided by the NHS and is held every week on Thursdays 12-3pm at the Community Centre, School Street, Syston. It's free and you can just drop in.

We are working with the NHS to better understand mental health needs and services in the Wreake Villages and how to make them accessible for everyone.

This month also saw the launch of Charnwood Time Bank, part of the wider Time4Leicestershire scheme. The aim is to create positive ways to share skills and knowledge, meet new people and make connections in your community.

You share your time or skill with someone and receive credits which you can then exchange for help or skills in return. We think this is a great initiative and hope it becomes a success across the community. You can find out more or offer to share a skill by visiting www.charnwoodtimebank.org.uk

As darker nights are drawing in, we would like to remind the community to keep good crime prevention habits.

WHAT TO BE AWARE OF?

There has been a general increase around the Charnwood area of thefts from motor vehicles and thefts of motor vehicles. Make sure your vehicle is locked and secure! DO NOT leave any valuables in your vehicle such as, handbags, wallets/purses, tools and make sure nothing if left on show!

WHAT TO KEEP AN EYE ON?

There has been an increase in burglaries throughout Charnwood! We would like to remind you to keep your homes and businesses secure. Ensure all windows and doors a locked, make your home look occupied,

Here is a checklist for when you are leaving your home unattended:

- Close and lock all windows and doors (even if you're only going out for a few minutes).
- Double-lock any doors.
- Make sure that any valuables are out of sight and away from letter boxes e.g. car keys, wallets/purses, handbags.
- Set your burglar alarm.
- Lock your shed, garage, and side/back gate.
- In the evening, shut curtains and leave a light on.
- If you are out all day/night, then it's advisable to use a light timer device to automatically turn on lights and radios when your home is unoccupied.
