

Footpath 4: Regent Street –Hoby Road –Church Lane/Back Lane- Footpath through to and across path to Thrussington Mill– Continue on footpath over Parish boundary – over fields to Hoby. Returned via new footpath near Brooksby bridge to bridge over the Wreak –rejoined footpath to Thrussington..

1. Footpath clearly marked throughout. Tried to walk footpath at Thrussington mill towards permitted paths along railway and Wreak but was unable because of flooded field so returned up bridle path to footpath along fields.



2. Footpath, slightly to left of old footpath, through fields clear and easy to follow, many new gates. Can easily spend 1-2 hours in Warner's woods.



3. At Hoby you can extend walk by turning left into the village and walking back to Thrussington via the road, take one of the numerous footpaths to Ragdale and return to Thrussington at top of Regent Street, or continue to Frisby and beyond.



4. Walked towards Brooksby and followed new footpath to bridge. Could not go to permitted path due to new fences and gates and new watercourse near broken bridge so followed footpath over metal bridge to Thrussington.



Also walked through all footpaths within village.
